• [A-1,Noun,<u>G3077</u>, lupe]

- **signifies pain," of body or mind**; it is used in the plural in <u>1</u> Peter 2:19 only, RV, "griefs" (AV, "grief"); here, however, it stands,
- by metonymy, for "things that cause sorrow, grievances;" hence Tyndale's rendering, "grief," for Wycliffe's "sorews;"
- everywhere else it is rendered "sorrow," except in <u>Hebrews</u> <u>12:11</u>, where it is translated "grievous" (lit., "of grief").


